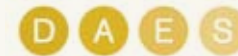
Our training Programmes covers a broad range of subjects including:

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

It is estimated that there are some four million employees whose work requires them to have some knowledge of substance misuse issues.

- The use, treatment and health implications of drugs and alcohol.
- Prevention, early detection, reducing risks and signposting to treatment services.

Our successful Parent and Carer Peer Education Programme cover the effects, risks, signs and how to raise concerns around drug and alcohol use. We also work in partnership with existing community groups providing informative workshops and participating in community events

YOUNG PEOPLE

Our Youth Drug Education Programmes involve providing young people with opportunities to:

- Inform on the content and delivery of their workshops.
- Access trained and informed adults on the subject of drug and alcohol use, who will listen without judging
- Debate and discussing positive and negative consequences of drug and alcohol use.
